Pineapple monkeys, deer, and flocks of yellow flowers surround this Andalusian country house. The two wings open out onto the landscape, creating a link with the local flora and animals. Respecting a part of the pristine landscape, the small house acts as a delicate threshold between industrial nature living. A central, open-plan living, dining, and kitchen space looks to panoramic views of the grounds on both sides. Traditional sliding glass partitions that open up completely to the rocks, mossy silent trees, and sheep grazing by to the west and the clouds hovering over the golden mountains to the east. Inspiring the mild weather climate, the flexible and dualized space provides a breath-taking and unobstructed way to live in and alongside nature. A previous work completes this remarkable setting, constituting one more of the links and locking the family into the land.
