Channelling the experiential artwork of Gordon Matta Clark, this co-working office transforms a 1950s apartment into an expressive and interrelated network of spaces for impromptu collaboration. The intriguing optical and spatial illusion engages a process of geometric subtraction. Interpenetrating oval and circular shapes are strategically removed from walls to link previously separate rooms. These compelling openings converge understandings of depth perception, as the cut-outs shift from 2D to 3D when one moves around them. ■

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
